

MOKAN PROGRAM HISTORY & OUTCOMES

MOKAN Basketball has over 15 years of experience preparing young men to play at the collegiate level. Since 2004, our program has had over 150+ college basketball players, including 70+ at the NCAA Division I level, generating \$31.3 in valued scholarship assistance.

TEAM LEVELS

MOKAN will operate an EYBL (1st team) & non-EYBL team (2nd team) at 15u, 16u & 17u age groups. Players for the 17u EYBL team are typically identified in advance of tryouts so players who choose to attend tryouts for this age group will be doing so for our MOKAN 2021 team.

NON-EYBL TEAM EXPERIENCE & SUCCESS

As mentioned above, our program has produced over 150+ college basketball players, many of which played on our non-EYBL teams. MOKAN provides players on these with a highly organized, dependable experience that incorporates high level coaching. We have had EYBL players go D2 and non-EYBL players go D1. HIGH SCHOOL TEAM FEES

All High School EYBL teams are fully funded with the help of Nike and other outside donors/sponsorships. The only cost for players on our EYBL teams is money for meals on road trips.

The player fees for our MOKAN 2023 (15u) and MOKAN 2022 (16u) is \$1,000. The MOKAN 2021 (17u) player fees is \$2,000. Fees cover tournament entry fees, coaching/administration, gym rental costs, a uniform for the season, gear package (shoes, bag, etc.) and team insurance. The 17u (MOKAN 2021) fee includes travel & lodging for all out of town trips. MOKAN 2023 (15u) and MOKAN 2022 (16u) team fees do not include travel -- parents are responsible for travel & lodging for players during out of town events. Player fees can be paid upfront at once or split into (4) equal payments March-June.

SEASON LENGT, PRACTICES & TOURNAMENTS

Players on our High School teams should plan to either practice or play in tournaments each weekend following tryouts through the end of May, and each weekend in July (High School players play with their High School teams during June). Full schedules will be provided prior to the start of the season.

TRYOUT PROCESS

Players that cannot attend the March 14th tryouts can attend on March 21st. Players will be contacted via phone to confirm whether or not they've made a team. MOKAN will make cuts following each day of tryouts.
